Clothesline Fractions Fractions is one of the "F" words in math. (The other is functions, but I'm not working with that grade level). Whenever these two words are said, teachers usually groan with frustration (that other F word).

Hang clothesline across the room. Have fraction cards ready. Group students so you know what fraction tent card you want them to try. (see "GoTo Sheet") Intro Have students help fill out the Cloze chart that reviews important concepts from the first 4 lessons. ### Fractions - Clothesline Math

The clothesline offers a visual representation of where fractions, decimals and percents are located in comparison with other numbers and with each other, which helps students grasp and retain the concept of fractions concretely. This visual can remain up in the classroom as long as you wish or it can serve as a wonderful math station (or a combination of both).

Once the easiest fractions are placed and the class agrees that they are placed correctly, allow all students to place a fraction from their group on the clothesline. After all fractions are placed, ask the class to look at the clothesline and determine whether students agree with the placement of the fractions.

### **Numbers - Clothesline Math**

One activity that I have used a few times this year - very successfully - is a fraction clothesline activity. This week, I was invited to visit a Grade 4/5 class to introduce decimals by linking them to what the students already knew about fractions (they have been working on fractions for a couple of weeks).

### **clothesline - Math with meaning**

Greater than, Less than or equal to a whole or  $1/2$ . We settled upon the following cards:  $1/4$ ,  $3/4$ ,  $4/4$ ,  $1/3$ ,  $4/3$ ,  $5/10$ ,  $2/5$ ,  $100\%$ ,  $3/8$ ,  $1\ 5/8$ ,  $1\ 7/8$ ,  $4/5$ ,  $11/6$ ,  $1\ 6/10$ ,  $1/10$ ,  $9/8$ ,  $12/8$ ,  $2$ . To start, I put the 0 toward the left of the line (when you are looking at it) and we practiced with a few whole numbers.

A clothesline number line is basically exactly as it sounds. It consists of length of string with moveable cards with either numbers or representations of quantity on them (e.g., ten frames, fingers, dots, images of fractions). Additionally, teachers could use one line or multiple lines that run parallel to each other.
