Minolta continued to offer 35 mm manual focus SLR cameras in its X-370, X-570, and X-700 from 1981, but slowly repositioned its cameras to appeal to a broader market. Minolta decided to abandon the high level of design and parts specifications of its earlier XD/XE line.

Unlike other manufacturers, Minolta invested much of its resources in the new autofocus cameras, at the expense of its manual focus SLRs, which were repositioned as amateur level cameras. This extreme 650-1300mm f/8-16 Manual Focus Lens from Bower is an economical way to achieve some ultra-telephoto photography, all the way up to 1300mm. This is a T-mount lens, which means that aperture is not communicated to or controlled by the camera body, and as such must be used only in aperture-priority auto-exposure mode (if your camera has it) or in the manual exposure mode.

The Minolta A-mount camera system was a line of photographic equipment from Minolta introduced in 1985 with the world's first integrated autofocus system in the camera body with interchangeable lenses. The system used a lens mount called A-mount, with a flange focal distance 44.50 mm, one millimeter longer, 43.5 mm, than the previous SR mount from 1958.

Minolta was founded in Osaka, Japan, in 1928. It is perhaps best known for making the first integrated auto-focus 35mm SLR camera system. In 1931, the company adopted its current name, an acronym for 'Mechanism, Instruments, Optics, and Lenses by TAshima.' The brand stands for Precision Optics, Image Quality and Innovation.

While manual focus is possible, unless the lens also has an aperture ring, you can't adjust the aperture, which defaults to its maximum. Some adapters incorporate a dandelion electronic chip that tells the camera you're using an adapter. This allows the camera to confirm the correct focus as it would if you were manually focusing with an OEM lens.
